



**ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY

**ORDINANCE NO. 2003-SPO-01**

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 98-SPO-01

WHEREAS, Ordinance number 98-SPO-01 was enacted by the Shoshone-Paiute Business Council on November 10, 1997, to protect human health and the environment through the regulation of Municipal Solid Waste Management, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance number 98-SPO-01 provides that all persons living on the Duck Valley Reservation must abide by this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Environmental Protection Program (TEPP) has seen a demonstrated need to include all contractors conducting business on the Duck Valley Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance number 98-SPO-01 does not specifically address the issue of contractor waste disposal;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED THAT,

- (1) All contractors and sub-contractors conducting business on the Duck Valley Indian Reservation must stipulate how solid waste management will be addressed; and
- (2) The Tribal Environmental Protection Program will be notified of such management plans and shall provide the proposed solid waste management provisions to the TEPP, to ensure the provisions are in compliance with Tribal Law and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA);

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT, if a contractor does not abide by this amendment, a penalty for non-compliance shall be assessed in the amount of \$500.00 per day until solid waste management is formally addressed and approved by the Tribal Environmental Protection Program. Funds collected under this Ordinance shall be made payable to the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes and deposited into the Tribal Solid Waste Program Account.

**CERTIFICATION**

It is hereby certified that the Shoshone-Paiute Business Council is composed of 6 Council Members of whom 4 constituting a quorum and a Chairman were present at a meeting held on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of

October, 2002, and that the foregoing ordinance was adopted by an affirmative vote of 4 FOR 0 AGAINST and 0 ABSTENTIONS pursuant to the authority contained in Article VI, Section (k) of the Constitution of the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes, approved April 20, 1936.
