


## Signs and Symptoms of Pesticide Exposure

Do you think you've been exposed to pesticides?



**Burning, or Irritation  
of the Nose or  
Throat**



**Eye Irritation**



**Headache**



**Nausea or Dizziness**



**Tremors, Slurred  
Speech, Loss of  
Muscle Coordination**

*"Children's exposure to Pesticides from all pathways (food, water, air, other are likely to be higher, because they eat more food, drink more water, and breathe more air per pound of body weight."*

If you think your symptoms could be from pesticides, tell your health care provider today. Your health care provider may ask for more information, such as a description of what happened, when it happened, and the name of the pesticide.
