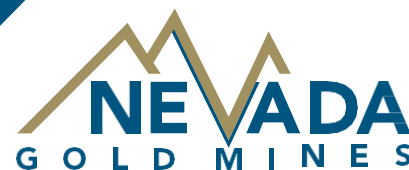

For Newe Numa Scholarship Foundation award recipients who have reached undergraduate sophomore, junior or senior status or are in a Master’s or Doctoral program in one of the following degree fields:

Applicants who receive funding from NSSF will be automatically screened for eligibility for this scholarship. No additional application or documents are required.

For eligible students taking part-time course work

- up to 10 credit hours through Great Basin College
- ineligible for the Newe Numa Scholarship Foundation

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility is based on the specific criteria in the scholarship application documents

-AND-

by meeting ONE of the following tribal eligibility criteria:

1. I am an enrolled tribal member of one of the following tribes:

- Duck Valley Shoshone-Paiute Tribe
- Duckwater Shoshone Tribe
- Elko Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone
- Ely Shoshone Tribe
- South Fork Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone
- Yomba Shoshone Tribe
- Wells Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone
- Battle Mountain Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone
- Fort McDermitt Paiute and Shoshone Tribe
- Confederated Tribes of the Goshute Reservation

-OR-

2. I am NOT an enrolled member of one of the tribes listed above, but:

- I am a resident of one of the tribes or its service area, AND
- my parent is a tribally enrolled member from at least one of the above communities
