SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This position is subject to random drug testing and a background check as a condition of employment. This individual operates Tribal vehicles and equipment on a regular basis. This individual works in hazardous environments (machinery, electricity, chemicals).

JOB SUMMARY:

Under the direct supervision of the Land and Natural Resources Director, the incumbent will be responsible for all equipment operation: Backhoe, Tractor, Trackhow, Off-road vehicles, noxious weed management, pesticides application, brushing, livestock gathering, livestock counting, repairs of Tribal facilities. Brand Inspecting for the State of Nevada and the Shoshone Paiute Tribes and other job duties as assigned.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- 1. Must be certified and/or will be required to take and pass a Private Applicator's Certification Test (required for the handling of restricted pesticides).
- 2. Will operate and maintain small and heavy equipment used during the course of employment.
- 3. Must know how to drive a tractor/backhoe and attachments responsibly, Equipment used for projects, movement of items, grave digging duties, arena maintenance, brushing, etc.
- 4. Will see to the proper care and maintenance of all Tribal Vehicles utilized in the department.
- 5. Will be responsible for the reporting of progress both verbally and in written form.
- 6. Must be or willing to learn the various noxious weeds on the reservation.
- 7. Will perform duties in welding and operation of electric, gas powered equipment and hand tools.
- 8. Will perform duties involving livestock including the care of, movement and handling and range riding.
- 9. Will be performing brand inspection duties for the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes.
- 10. Will perform duties related to the State Brand Inspector (Reporting, Payment Collections, etc.)
- 11. Will perform lead duties over projects and temporary staff.
- 10. Will perform other related duties as assigned by the supervisor.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must have a valid Idaho or Nevada State driver's license and be insurable with the Tribes' insurance carrier.
- 2. High School Diploma or equivalent preferred. Similar work experience may be substituted.

- 3. Must be physically able to perform all job duties in various conditions and weather.
- 4. Must be willing to work long hours and weekends, when necessary.
- 4. Experience in Livestock handling and care.
- 4. Must have a "Private Applicator certification" **AND/OR** pass a Private Applicator's Certification Test when it becomes available (required for the handling of restricted pesticides).

PHYSICAL DEMAND:

Incumbent is required to walk in rough terrain, stand, stoop, bend, kneel, climb and work in hot/cold weather conditions. Will be required to setup equipment to perform job duties. Required to lift and carry objects that weigh over 50 to 100 pounds.
