NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Indian Reservation will receive sealed Bids for the New School Project Environmental Study, at 1623 Hospital Loop, Owyhee, Nevada, until 2:00 PM Mountain Time Wednesday, August 16, 2023, at which time all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 10:00 AM Mountain Time Thursday, August 17, 2023 in the Tribal Council Chambers.

All Bids must be submitted, and all work shall be done, in full and strict compliance with:

1. The RFP for this phase of the project;
2. Any Special Conditions for this project;

Project bidding documents are available for examination Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm at the Projects Division office of the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes, 1012 Idaho State Hwy. 51, Owyhee, NV, 89832. Generally, the work covered by the Pre-Development and Permitting for the New School project consists of the required ground surveys, field surveys, desktop assessments, and working with the School District or the School District's representative and the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes or the Shoshone-Paiute Tribe's Representative for facility design required for the NEPA process and the selected service provider will be responsible for managing and completing the evaluation. See RFP for full Scope of Work.

The Owner reserves the right to hold all Bids for 60 days, to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality or irregularity in any Bid, to accept the Bid deemed in the best interest of the Owner, and to rebid the project until a satisfactory bid is received.

Bids will not be accepted that are submitted electronically.

There shall be endorsed upon the outside of the envelope containing the Bid, the following:

1. "Shoshone-Paiute Tribes, New School Project – BID ENCLOSED"
2. The name of the person, firm, corporation, or joint venture submitting the Bid.
3. Acknowledgement of the Addenda, if any.

Any deficient Bid received will be resealed and returned to the Bidder immediately.

All Work (Phase I and Phase II) shall be substantially complete within 6-10 months (including the 30-day comment period for the EA).

Selection of the bids will be based upon:



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1. Understanding the scope of work as evidenced by the approach outlined;
2. Competence, technical ability, and related experience;
3. Knowledge of NEPA and other federal environmental regulations;
4. Estimated cost projections;
5. Responsiveness to the Request for Proposal;
6. References;
7. Previous working history with the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes.
