Action: The Shoshone-Paiute Tribes, in collaboration with the BIA and Federal Highways, is updating the Tribe's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and Tribal Transportation Improvement Projects (TTIP) Priority list. This Study is funded through the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The LRTP and TTIP will provide recommendations to improve automobile, bus, bicycle, equestrian, and aviation for the next 5, 10, and 20 years. Your knowledge and experience on recommendations for future transportation improvements for the community is needed.
