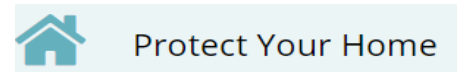
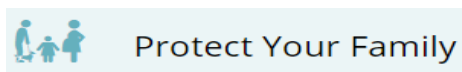
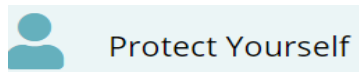


When you call this number, the Nurse will conduct an over the phone assessment and provide you with additional instructions including lab testing if determined.
