**IF A Person is Positive with COVID-19, *What does it Mean?***

**For The Individual Positive w/COVID-19:** That you are positive with a virus that effects the lungs and can lead to pneumonia, bronchitis, etc. If your immune system is compromised (diabetes, asthma, heart issues, etc) this could lead to more severe respiratory/lung issues.

\*A positive individual will continue to be Quarantined (with their household).

\*OCHF will meet with the positive individual and will assist with medication, instructions and will monitor the individual 5-days per week.

\*COVID-19 virus is very contagious. Please stay Quarantined & Do not leave your residence.

\*The OCHF will help & assist the COVID-19 individual through this entire process.

**For The Community:** It means the virus has been in Duck Valley for at least one-week and probably for several weeks, already.

\*All the community can do is: **\*Please stay home. \*Please do not panic. \*Please stay calm.**

\*When at home & experiencing the following symptoms **PLEASE CALL (775)757-2415, ext. #4237.** A Nurse will conduct an over the phone assessment and provide you with instructions.

- COUGHING

- CHEST PAIN
- DIZZINESS
- FATIGUE
- DIARRHEA
- LOSS OF SMELL (plus one of the above)
