COVID-19 Community Information & Reminders

As of Monday, May 18: 43-Total tested for COVID-19, 43-Negative, 0-Pending

The OCHF has made great efforts to keep the facility clean & safe. Along with our 2-Housekeepers, we have utilized 2-other housekeepers from the Tribal work pool to do only cleaning and disinfecting of all patient care and waiting room areas. All nursing staff clean and disinfect their areas as well. The OCHF is a safe and clean environment for all patients to be confident that you are receiving the safest care possible. We are doing all we can to ensure the OCHF is a COVID-19 free environment.

The OCHF is operating 2-clinics; a regular outpatient clinic and a COVID-19 testing clinic. We have separated these 2-clinics so patients who come to the regular clinic are free from COVID-19 exposure. Please do not put off your important health care needs.
