## MOBILE COVID-19 VACCINATION UNIT TO ARRIVE TO DUCK VALLEY APRIL 25

Owyhee, NV- A Mobile COVID-19 Vaccination Unit will arrive to Duck Valley April 25 to host a community-wide vaccination clinic.

**The event site will be the parking lot in front of the Owyhee Jail and next to the HDC from 10am to 6pm local time. No Appointment Needed**

This event is a part of the United States COVID-19 Vaccination Program directed under President Biden and carried out by FEMA. This federally supported Mobile Community Vaccination Centers (CVCs), will be touring across Nevada in rural areas with little infrastructure with the goal to get rural Nevadans vaccinated. The CVC units will be visiting other tribal nations across the state.

They will be utilizing the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine, meaning only 1 (one) dose will be required to be fully vaccinated.

You **do not need an appointment** to get vaccinated and certified medical staff will be present to assist you. The event is open to the **entire** community and **neighboring** communities and you do not need to be a tribal member.
