Duck Valley- 15 tested, 0 confirmed, 14 negative, 1 waiting

Idaho- 1453 confirmed cases (Ada-529, Blaine- 458, Twin Falls-79, Canyon-161, Elmore-16, Owyhee-4, Bannock-5, Bingham-2, Jerome - 30, Payete - 8, Gem - 9, Sho-Ban - 1)

Nevada- 2979 confirmed cases (Elko-11, Clark-2444, Washoe-461, Humbolt-18, Nye-10, Lyon-7, Douglas-10, White Pine - 2, Carson City - 16, Pyramid Lake Tribe - 1)

The Tribes intent of the COVID 19 Pandemic is to "Protect, Mitigate, Respond, and Recover in a safe, efficient and fiscally responsible manner to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency declaration"

The OCHF nursing staff are doing daily health watches for the EOC and OCHF staff. A reading of your temperature and a questionnaire are being conducted.

Continued reports of tribal and non members returning to the reservation not following tribal policies on "Stay Home" proclamation. Increase in people returning to reservation.

All tribal and OCHF staff and visitors are required to wear masks in the hallway and at meetings at all times

Implementing new radio messages to further provide community with updates on available services and health information

Working on logistical and support action needs for return of tribal workers at the end of the month. Placing check points for employees, purchasing PPE and equipment

Senior Citizens program "Drive thru" service of hot meals is a continuing for the elders.

Food Distribution Program did start a emergency food care box program for local residence that are not currently receiving regular commodity service or Food Stamp assistance.

EOC staff assisted with the assembling and delivering the emergency food care boxes to local residence

Purchase of disinfectant (EPA - certified viral) and atomizer was purchased. Products will be used in cleaning of predetermined sites and alt housing units after use.

Alternate living unit plan completed and aquired of one house from Duck Valley Housing Authority. Locating and acquiring other units is on going. The one DVHA acquired unit is furnished and supplied for occupation.

Wildland fire response on April 12, 2020 on the DV reservation. Local rancher burning fields. No containment or response issues reported.
