Duck Valley- 18 tested, 18 negative, No new test conducted as of 4/22/20 1800 hrs

Idaho- 1802 confirmed cases (Ada-630, Blaine- 484, Twin Falls-123, Canyon-215, Elmore-28, Owyhee-6, Bannock-8, Bingham-3, Jerome - 44, Payete -11, Gem - 10, Sho-Ban - 1)

Nevada- 4208 confirmed cases (Elko-12, Clark-3314, Washoe-710, Humbolt-34, Nye-29, Lyon-19, Douglas-17, Lyon - 20, White Pine - 3, Carson City - 31, Unknown - 32, Pyramid Lake Tribe - 1)

Continued reports of tribal and non members returning to the reservation not following tribal policies on "Stay Home" proclamation. Increase in people returning to reservation.

The OCHF nursing staff are doing daily health watches for the EOC and OCHF staff. A reading of your temperature and a questionnaire are being conducted.

All tribal and OCHF staff and visitors are required to wear masks in the hallway and at meetings at all times

OCHF has received a COVID 19 anlysis testing machine and test kits. It was received from Indian Health Service.

Implementing new radio messages to further provide community with updates on available services and health information

Working on logistical and support action needs for return of tribal workers at the end of the month. Placing check points for employees, purchasing PPE and equipment

Senior Citizens program "Drive thru" service of hot meals is a continuing for the elders.

Food Distribution Program did start a emergency food care box program for local residence. The program is currently not in operation but has been approved for another round in the future

EOC is sponsoring a art contest for kids and teens. This was created as a support action for community activity they can do at home. A flyer has been created with details about the contest. Art work will be placed on the cover of future IAPs and other EOC material.

A 50 foot reefer trailer from Roadway in Wells, NV is set up for the storage of the donated food from Nevada Gold. NV Gold has delivered food on 4/22/2020, the reefer set up is in the front of the HDC and is a distribution point to senior citizens Wednesday mid morning. Deliveries will be

Nevada Gold food boxes delivered to senior citizens that were unable to pick up a box on Wednesday. Total of 250 boxes, 110 picked up, 125 delivered, 15 undelivered as of 4/24
