**Duck Valley- 24 tested, 24 negative, No new test information as of 5/4/20 0800 hrs**

**Idaho-** 2061 confirmed cases (Ada-705, Blaine- 497, Twin Falls-196, Canyon-258, Elmore-30, Owyhee-8, Bannock-11, Bingham-4, Jerome - 55, Payete -16, Gem - 13)

**Nevada-** 5472 confirmed cases ( Elko-15, Clark-4274, Washoe-977, Humbolt-49, Nye-37, Lyon-34, Douglas-21, White Pine - 3, Carson City - 48, Churchill - 3, Mineral - 4, Lander - 7)

Continued reports of tribal and non members returning to the reservation not following tribal policies on "Stay Home" proclamation. Increase in people returning to reservation.

All EOC staff are doing self temperature log at the EOC. No longer need to report to OCHF

All tribal staff, OCHF staff and visitors are required to wear masks in the hallway and at meetings at all times

Burn Restrictions are being put in place for the reservation during the emergency declaration.

Two fires called in over the weekend

Implementing new radio messages to further provide community with updates on available services and health information

Working on logistical and support action needs for return of tribal workers at the end of the month. Planning for check points for employees, purchasing PPE and equipment

Senior Citizens program "Drive thru" service of hot meals is on Monday thru Thursday for the

Food Distribution Program did start a emergency food care box program for local residence.

Contractor addendum for health screening checks are being impliment with EOC staff at job sites.

EOC created and are staffing a positive case tracing group. This was developed to assist OCHF with COVID 19 case research and planning.
