Duck Valley- 35 tested, 35 negative, No new test information as of 5/12/20 1800 hrs

Idaho- 2293 confirmed cases (Ada-744, Blaine- 506, Twin Falls-280, Canyon-274, Elmore - 31, Owyhee-8, Bannock-13, Bingham-4, Jerome - 81, Payete -17, Gem - 16)

Nevada- 6311 confirmed cases (Elko-18, Clark-4869, Washoe-1116, Humbolt-69, Nye-48, Lyon-45, Douglas-24, White Pine - 3, Carson - 58, Churchill - 5, Mineral - 4, Lander - 19, Lincoln - 2)

Continued reports of tribal members not following the tribal policies on "Stay Home" proclamation.

All EOC staff are doing self temperature log at the EOC.

All staff and visitors are required to wear masks in the hallway and at meetings at all times

Burn Restrictions are put in place for the reservation during the emergency declaration. One reported "suspicious man made" wildland fire on south

Food Distribution Program did start a emergency food care box program from USDA for local residence. EOC staff have been assisting with building and delivery of the boxes

Contractor addendum for health screening checks are being impliment with EOC staff at job sites. All contractors have been supporting the safety measure.

EOC positive case tracing group is doing online training and plan development. Weekly training is being implimented with assistance from OCHF.
