Food Distribution Program is looking for applicants for the emergency food care box program from USDA for local residence.

Contractor addendum for health screening checks are being impliment with EOC staff at job sites. All contractors have been supporting the safety measure.

EOC positive case tracing group is doing online training and plan development. Weekly table top exercise is being implimented with assistance from OCHF.

Continued locating and purchasing of PPE and other supplies for COVID 19 measures

Assistance with logistical support to the Election committee "Drive thru" voting on May 21. Voting will take place in front of the HDC.

Traffic control assistances was given to Raft River Electric on "down power line" along China Town Road. Power was restored around 1030 NV Gold delivered some items for the EOC assistance cache. Items received were diapers (adult and infant) and baby formula
